**Part B. CV SUMMARY** (max. 3500 characters, including spaces)

**During the period 2010-2019** my activity in the UPV/EHU has covered three main domains: teaching, research and management. First, I have taught introductory courses in linguistics in undergraduate programmes, as well as courses on language acquisition and bilingualism in the Masters programmes *Language Acquisition in Multilingual Settings* and *Theoretical and Applied Linguistics*, which have both received the Quality & Excellence award. Second, I have conducted theoretical and empirical research on monolingual and bilingual children's acquisition of vocabulary, morpho-syntax and semantics-pragmatics. Third, I have participated in the management of the Department of *Linguistics and Basque Studies* as Head of Department from October 2017 to October 2018.

**Research groups.** I have been a member of 10 projects of long duration funded by public institutions, and currently I am the main researcher of one of these (Basque Government 2016-2021). During the last 10 years, I have been able to present over 80 oral and written (poster) papers in national and international conferences held in Europe (Germany, France, Norway, Portugal, Croatia, United Kingdom) and America (Canada, USA, Mexico, Brasil). I have also worked in some European universities as a visiting scholar (Cambridge) or as an



invited speaker/teacher (Frankfurt, Kaiserslautern, Utrecht, Mexico). My participation in several European networks, such as the COST (2006-2010), has fostered international collaboration with renowned researchers on multiauthored papers (Katsos et al. 2012, 2016; Varlocosta et al. 2015), some of which have been published in Q1 journals.

**Publications.** Since 2010 I have (co-)authored **16 journal papers** (Frontiers of Psychology, International Journal of Bilingualism, *Lingua*, *First Language*, Language Acquisition, *Romance RL*, *Infancia y Aprendizaje*; *PNAS*, *Languages*, *Uztaro*...) some of these published in Q1 Journals, **6** papers in proceedings, **14 book chapters** (*Benjamins*, *Multilingual Matters*, *Springer*, *Kluwer*, UNAM, CIESAS), and **one** co-edited **book** (UPV/EHU). Many of these publications deal with subjects requiring the expertise of professionals working in other areas, such as psychology, pedagogy, didactics, speech therapy...).

I have been on the organizing committee of the international conference of *Asociación para el Estudio de la Adquisición del Lenguaje* (AEAL Bilbao 2013) and on the scientific committees of several other conferences (*Going Romance*, *IV Romance Turn*, *IX Romance Turn*, *Hispanic Linguistic Symposium*, AESLA 2016, 2019, *Generative Approaches to Language Acquisition*...). I have also reviewed papers for specialist journals, such as *Infancy*, *Resla*, *Languages*, *International Journal of Bilingualism*, *Bilingualism: Language and Cognition*, *Journal of Child Language*, *Probus*, *First Language*, *Frontiers of Psychology*, *Revista de Logopedia*, *Foniatría y Audiología*, *International Journal of Basque Studies*, as well as chapters of monographic volumes published by Benjamins, Multilingual Matters, Kluwer, etc.

In addition to the three international PhDs, which obtained the maximum grade, I have supervised several Master theses and many final degree projects. I have been a member of 10 PhD defence committees, both inside and outside the UPV/EHU.
