Summary of CV

This section describes briefly a summary of your career in science, academic and research; the main scientific and technological achievements and goals in your line of research in the medium -and long- term. It also includes other important aspects or peculiarities.

During my research career, I have worked in the research field of psycholinguistics. In 1999, I enrolled the Linguistics Ph.D program (UPV/EHU). In 2000, I was awarded a research collaboration grant to work at the Cognitive Neuroscience Research Group headed by Prof. Nuria Sebastián-Gallés at the Universitat de Barcelona (UB). There I was familiarized with research methods and topics related to the group's interests, such as the processes involved in the perception and production of language by newborns, adults, and neuropsychological patients, with special emphasis on bilingualism.

In 2001, I enrolled the Cognitive Science and Language Ph.D. program (UB) under the supervision of Dr. Albert Costa. I designed and carried out experimental research in language production with monolinguals and bilinguals, focusing on the processes of lexical access and sentence production. I focused on the study of bilingual speakers' language selection mechanisms during speech production. This research was the core of my Ph.D thesis entitled Lexical representation and selection in bilingual speech production (2006).

Between 2006-2009 I worked with Prof. Martin Pickering at the University of Edinburgh (UK) as a post-doctoral fellow (Spanish Government) and a Marie Curie Intra-European fellow. There I investigated two main topics: (i) the encoding of agreement and (ii) the processes of selection of syntactic structures in speech production.

From 2010 until 2020, I became a Permanent I have been working as a Juan de la Cierva (2010-2013), a Research Fellow (2013-2014) a Ramón y Cajal researcher (2014-2020) and now a Permanent Senior Researchers at The Bilingual Mind group led by Prof. Itziar Laka. There I have established myself as an independent researcher: I led four research projects exploring topics related to language processing and bilingualism: the processes of agreement encoding in native and non-native speakers, the processes involved in language activation and selection in bilinguals or cross-linguistic effects in bilingual language production and comprehension. Three of the projects were financed by the Spanish Government and 1 by the European Commission. In addition, I coordinate the participation of the Bilingual Mind group as a member of the Red Albert Costa sobre efectos de lengua extranjera relacionados con la aculturación (ACELERA), formed by 8 national research groups and coordinated by Prof. Jon Andoni Duñabeitia (Nebrija University).

As a teaching experience, I have taught both at the graduate (Master in Linguistics: Fundamentals of Psycholinguistics and Neurolinguistics 2010/11, 2011/12,



2012/13, 2013/14; 2020/21; Research Seminar on Language Processing 2013/14; 2017/18; Research Seminar in the Neurocognition of Language 2014/15; Advanced Course in Psycholinguistics and Neurolinguistics 2016/17; 2021/22; Methods on Linguistic Research 2020/21; 2021/22; Master in Linguistics and Basque Philology: Applied Linguistics 2011/12, 2012/13) and undergraduate levels (Basque Studies: Psycholinguistics 2015/16, 2016/17). I have supervised the Master dissertations of 8 students, and I am currently supervising the PhD projects of two of them: Ms. Victoria Cano (on the effects of healthy aging in language processing) and Ms. Marta Sánchez (on the processing of psychological predicates).

In sum, during my research career I have conducted and been directly involved in several research projects, and I have acquired a strong and solid background in linguistics and psycholinguistics, a good training in experimental methods as well as a good training in student supervision.

As my publications show, I collaborate with several international researchers. I have presented the results of my research at several national and international conferences, and I have published most of my work in ISI journals. I am also a regular reviewer for several international ISI journals (e.g., Journal of Memory and Language; Bilingualism: Language and Cognition; Cognition, Acta Psychologica, and others), as well as for several research funding agencies (Spanish ANEP, French ANR). Since November 2016 until December 2022 I was a Young Corresponding Member of Jakiunde, the Basque Academy of Sciences, Arts and Letters.

Summary of professional activity

I am a psycholinguist specializing in bilingual language processing. I earned my Ph.D. in 2006 under Prof. Albert Costa, focusing on lexical representation and selection in bilingual speech production. As a postdoctoral fellow with Prof. Martin Pickering (2006-2009), I researched agreement encoding and syntactic selection. Since 2010, I have been a researcher at The Bilingual Mind group (UPV/EHU) led by Prof. Itziar Laka, where I have been leading several projects funded by the Spanish Government. My work examines agreement encoding, bilingual language activation and selection, cross-linguistic effects, aging-related language processing, and the role of emotion in lexical access and syntax.

I have organized scientific events, including the XVI International Symposium of Psycholinguistics (2023) and the Workshop on Language Processing in Aging (2024). I engage in outreach activities, contribute to open science, and review for international journals and funding agencies. I have extensive teaching experience at graduate levels and currently supervise three Ph.D. students. I actively collaborate with international researchers and I was a Young Corresponding Member of Jakiunde (2016-2022).

Relevant results: The repetition of a statement increases its credibility (the illusory truth effect). We tested whether the illusory truth effect persists across languages and scripts. In two experiments, Italian-English and Greek-English unbalanced bilinguals were exposed to written unknown trivia statements in English. Participants rated the truthfulness of the same (repeated) or new statements, which were presented either in the same language as in the exposure phase (English) or in a different language (Italian, Exp1, or Greek, Exp2). RTs were faster when information was repeated in the same rather than in a different language, suggesting increased processing fluency in the former than in the latter case. Truth ratings yielded an illusory truth effect: repeated statements were considered more truthful than new statements. Interestingly, the magnitude of the illusory truth effect remained regardless of whether the repetition was in the same or in a different language and persisted even when the different language condition also entailed a different script. The results suggest that the language of information presentation is not a critical factor to affect the illusory truth effect, despite the fact that repetition in the same language increases processing speed. We interpret our results in light of the referential theory (Unkelbach & Rom, 2017), attributing the illusory truth effect to conceptual fluency induced by the overlap of activated conceptual representations in bilingual memory.

Relevant results: This registered report article investigates the role of language as a dimension of social categorization. Our critical aim was to investigate whether categorization based on language occurs even when the languages coexist within the same sociolinguistic context, as is the case in bilingual communities. Bilingual individuals of two bilingual communities, the Basque Country (Spain) and Veneto (Italy), were tested using the memory confusion paradigm in a ‘Who said what?’ task. Bill Murray's character in the movie *Lost in Translation* exemplifies the way we feel when trying to communicate with someone that does not speak the same language. Often, in such cases, the exchange of information is disrupted and even translation does not seem to capture the communicative intention of the interlocutors. Thus, to be able to speak two languages at will is obviously a worthy skill to have. However, there is also a potential drawback, namely, bilingual speakers need to control their production in such a way that the two languages do not end up mixed in an inappropriate manner during the discourse. For example, if Bill Murray would have been an English-Japanese bilingual, he would have had to be careful not to use English words when speaking to the director of the commercial. This poses interesting problems to researchers in cognitive psychology: How does a bilingual speaker control her two languages during speech production? How do bilingual speakers manage to avoid massive interference from the language they are not using? What is the role of the language-not-in-use during lexical retrieval and phonological encoding? The articles included in this issue aim at discussing the answers that have been put forward to some of these questions.
